

Galloway 100 Touring Assembly Instructions Sunday 12th May 2024

INTRODUCTION

Thank you for supporting the second **Galloway 100 Touring Assembly**. Below you will find some instructions and tips to read ahead of Sunday's event.

TIMETABLE

The event will follow this approximate time schedule:

Start: Ernespie Farm Centre, Old Military Road, Castle Douglas, DG7 3JG

(NX 777 638) @ **09.30** for **10.00** departure

Lunch Halt: Clann, St Mary Street, Kirkcudbright, DG6 4AE

@ approx. 12.30-14.00

Finish: Ernespie Farm Centre, Old Military Road, Castle Douglas, DG7 3JG

(NX 777 638) @ **15.30 (approx.)**

COSTS

The cost is **£10 per person** which includes lunch, Souvenir Rally Plate and all printed Paperwork, which will be issued at the start on Sunday. Lunch Tickets will be distributed on the morning of the event, along with your route instructions.

Payments can be made in **cash** at the start on Sunday, please (* *assuming you have not already paid online*).

ROUTE

About 100 miles measured on a normal vehicle trip meter and is defined by Tulip Diagrams and intermediate distances to $1/10^{th}$ of a mile. It includes A, B and unclassified roads, however the majority of the mileage is on unclassified (yellow) roads. The route has been designed around a <30mph average so take your time and enjoy the views. **Remember it's not a timed trial.**

FUEL & TOILETS

Fuel stations and Public Toilets can be found in Castle Douglas, St John's Town of Dalry, New Galloway (toilets only), Kirkcudbright and Dalbeattie. (These, mostly, will need a diversion from the route so make sure to adjust your mileage between route instructions accordingly.)

FOOD & DRINK

Lunch at **Clann** in Kirkcudbright is included in the entry fee and will comprise of Soup, Sandwich and a hot Drink, between **12:30 and 14:00.** (* *Please let us know ASAP of any dietary requirements*).

Food and Drink will be available to purchase at Ernespie Farm before and after the event. We are grateful the owners are allowing us to use Ernespie Farm as start and finish venue free of charge so please return their kindness by supporting them and buying something on the day or coming back some other time.

ROAD ETIQUETTE

Please leave 200m between you and the vehicle in front especially on narrower sections of road, don't form convoys and please use passing places to allow just that. If another road user catches you up please allow them to pass at the earliest opportunity, their need might be much greater than yours. On a Sunday some of the roads will likely be popular with cyclists walkers and horse riders please be prepared to meet them in unexpected places take your time and give them space.

TRAILER PARKING

If you wish to tow your car to and from the event, we can offer a Trailer Park at a secure location in Abercromby Industrial Estate, Castle Douglas, DG7 1LH. This is approximately 2.5 miles from the Start/Finish venue. Please do not take trailers to Ernespie Farm Park as there is not space.
